# Dad of Indian kid: I 'dumped' body

Two days after the discovery of a child's body in a culvert in Richardson, Texas, the police on Tuesday confirmed that it was indeed of the missing three-year-old Indian-American Sherin Mathews, who had been adopted by her NRI foster parents from an orphanage in Bihar two years ago.

Even before completion of the identification process, the police on Monday arrested Sheryn's adoptive father, Wesley Mathews, and charged with causing "Injury to a Child", a first-degree felony punishable by life or from five to 99 years in prison. The arrest came about after the 37-year-old Mathews admitted to police that he "dumped" the toddler's body near his home after she choked on her milk while he "physically assisted" her.

Mathews, who was originally arrested on October 7 and let off on a bond of \$2,50,000 a

day later, is now being held in the Richardson Central Jail, with his new bond set at \$1 million.

Richardson police officials said on Tuesday that the Dallas Medical Examiner's Office used dental records to confirm the identity of the body that was found in the culvert on Sunday. Her cause of death has not been determined yet and police have not said whether or not they suspect foul play, the *Dallas Morning News* reported.

Mathews voluntarily went to the police on Monday, along with his attorney, and offered a new account of what happened the night of October 7.

Citing an arrest warrant affidavit, *Fox News* reported that Mathews told police that he and the girl were in the house's garage when she refused to drink her milk. She allegedly wouldn't listen. She then began drinking and the father stepped in to "physically assisted" her drinking the liquid. Sherin began choking, coughing and breathing slowly at some point, according to the affidavit.

Mathews told the police that he couldn't feel a pulse on his daughter and believed she died. He then said he removed the toddler's body from the house.

## War of words spreads to soldier's widow, Trump

Washington: A fallen soldier's angry widow joined the stormy dispute with President Donald Trump over his response to her husband's death, declaring that his failure to remember the soldier's name in last week's condolence call "made me cry."

He retorted the call was "very respectful" and her accusation about her husband's name simply wasn't true. Though Trump refused to let the new round of complaints go unanswered, he steered clear of the insults he exchanged last week with a congresswoman

who had overheard the sympathy call.

The President spoke in public at two events during the day, including his awarding of the military Medal of Honor to a Vietnam-era Army medic, and made no mention of the case of Sgt La David Johnson, one of four soldiers killed October 4 in a firefight with terrorists. In addition to criticising Trump, Myeshia Johnson, the sergeant's widow, also complained bitterly that she had not been able to see her husband's body.

## Belt, Road finds mention in CPC constitution

Beijing: Chinese President Xi Jinping's ambitious Belt and Road project, which irks India, has found a mention in the constitution of the Communist Party of China (CPC). The inclusion of the project in the ruling party's constitution, which was amended at the CPC congress, means that Beijing will push more to materialise Xi's dream of connecting Asia and Europe through a network of roads and waterways. This can spell more worries for India as it has opposed the initiative because its chief component passes through the Kashmir that is held by Islamabad and claimed by New Delhi.

## Xi emerges as China's most powerful leader since Mao

Beijing: President Xi Jinping on Tuesday attained iconic status enjoyed by modern China's founder Chairman Mao Zedong, with his name and ideology enshrined in the Constitution of the ruling CPC, as he secured a second five-year term with sights firmly set on an unprecedented third.

The once-in-five-years Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC) on its final day approved Xi's ideology to be written into its Constitution, which is in addition to the title of "core leader" conferred on him last year that analysts say enhances his leadership status above other leaders of the party.

Till now, only the thoughts of Mao and his successor Deng Xiaoping were enshrined in the Constitution of the world's longest ruling Communist Party, interpreting the complex doctrine of Marxism with Chinese characteristics.

The thoughts of Deng, China's reformist leader, were added posthumously. CPC historians compare 64-year-old Xi with party founder Mao. The thoughts of two of Xi's predecessors, Jiang Zemin and Hu

Jintao, were mentioned in the Constitution but not their names. This makes Xi only the third leader to have his thoughts on governance enshrined, which will now be part of school textbooks all over China.

But Xi, who is regarded as the most powerful leader heading the party, presidency and the military in the last five years did not have his way in the Congress as he had to settle for a compromise to let his closest aide, Wang Qishan, 69, to retire in an apparent trade off with other powerful factions in the party to get his name enshrined in the Constitution.

The name of Wang, who headed the massive anti-corruption drive targeting "tigers and flies" in the party in which over a million officials punished, was not found in the 204-strong list of elected members of the Central Committee, the top most policy body of the CPC. The "election" to the Central Committee held in a most secretive functioning of the party, is essential to get into the 25-member Politburo and the seven-member Standing Committee which virtually rules the country.

## Jailed Hong Kong activist Joshua Wong released on bail

Hong Kong: Jailed democracy activists Joshua Wong and Nathan Law were released on bail on Tuesday pending an appeal against convictions for their role in the 2014 Umbrella Movement protests.

The jail sentences handed down by the city's Court of Appeal in August came amid mounting fears that Beijing is tightening its grip on the semi-autonomous city and that rule of law is being compromised.

Wong, 21, who became the face of the mass pro-democracy protests while still a teenager, was jailed for six months while Law, 24, was imprisoned for eight months.

They were granted bail at the Court of Final Appeal until November 7, the first appearance in the appeal proceedings.

A third activist, Alex Chow, who was jailed for seven months alongside Law and Wong, was not part of Tuesday's hearing. AFP

ISRAELI PRIME MINISTER TO VISIT INDIA IN JANUARY  
Jerusalem: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Tuesday said he will visit India in January, six months after his Indian counterpart Narendra Modi visited the Jewish state. Netanyahu would be only the second Israeli Prime Minister to visit India. His visit next year would be happening almost 15 years after Ariel Sharon visited New Delhi in 2003.

## EU President suggests Brexit could be halted

Brussels: European Council President Donald Tusk on Tuesday said the future relationship between the UK and the European Union (EU) was dependant on the former and suggested that Brexit could be halted. Speaking at the European Parliament in Strasbourg, Tusk stressed the importance of unity among the remaining 27 EU member states irrespective of which way negotiations go, reports *Efe* news. "It is in fact up to London how this will end: with a good deal, no deal or no Brexit," said Tusk. He said the bloc could take on "every scenario as long as we are not divided." It was not the first time since the Brexit process began that the top official has floated the possibility of the UK remaining in the EU; he touched on it after an EU leaders summit in June, drawing inspiration from John Lennon's song "Imagine". IANS

## IMF chief warns of 'dark future' over climate change

Riyadh: The world faces a "dark future" if it fails to tackle climate change and inequality, IMF managing director Christine Lagarde warned on Tuesday. "If we don't address these issues... We will be moving to a dark future" in 50 years, she told a major economic conference in the Saudi capital.

On climate change, Lagarde said, "We will be roasted, roasted and grilled, if the world fails to take critical decisions on the issue." In 2015, around 195 nations signed the Paris climate agreement which set measures to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to prevent temperatures rising by more than two degrees in around 50 years. Lagarde also called for tackling inequality between men and women and countries that are "haves" and those that are "have nots". AFP

## Netanyahu: World should take care of Kurds' future

Jerusalem: Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Tuesday said Israel had "great sympathy" for Kurdish aspirations and that the world should concern itself with their wellbeing. Netanyahu was speaking at a memorial ceremony for far-right Israeli tourism minister Rehavam Zeevi, assassinated by Palestinians in Jerusalem in 2001. Zeevi, he said, went on a secret mission Iraq's autonomous Kurdistan region in 1960s and supervised setting up of an Israeli army field hospital there.

## New cyber attack hits Russia, Ukraine

Kiev: A cyber attack hit a Ukrainian international airport and three Russian media outlets just four months after the "NotPetya" malware spread from two countries across the world. Cybersecurity experts said the computer virus also appeared to have spread to Turkey and Germany as the day progressed — but that its size appeared to be relatively small. Ukraine's Odessa International Airport said on Facebook that its "information system" stopped functioning on Tuesday afternoon.

## TILLERSON IN PAKISTAN ON MAIDEN VISIT

Islamabad: US Secretary of State Rex Tillerson on Tuesday arrived in Pakistan on a whirlwind visit to normalise bilateral ties strained after President Donald Trump accused the country of providing safe havens to terrorist groups.

## IRAQI KURD POSTPONES POLLS FOR 8 MONTHS

Arbil (Iraq): Parliament in Iraq's autonomous Kurdistan region decided to hold legislative elections in eight months after they were delayed amid tensions over disputed territory with the Central Government in Baghdad.

## CATALAN LEADERS PLAN LEGAL CHALLENGE

Madrid: Catalonia's political leaders intend to bring a legal challenge to prevent the Spanish Government from removing them from office and taking over running the region to stop its push for independence, a regional spokesman said.

## HACKERS BREACH PLASTIC SURGERY CLINIC IN UK

London: A top British plastic surgery clinic, known to have high-profile clients, on Tuesday said it is "horrified" after hackers allegedly stole terabytes of data during a recent cyber-attack. London Bridge Plastic Surgery said its IT experts and police found evidence of the breach.
