HERO MOTOCORP HANDS OVER 70 MOTORCYCLES AND SCOOTERS TO HARYANA GOVERNMENT FOR FRONT-LINE HEALTH WORKERS

LAUNCHES 'CORONA WARRIORS ON WHEELS' IN ASSOCIATION WITH HEALTH DEPARTMENT, HARYANA
